CULTURE CODE

1. Personal Evangelism: It is the responsibility of every believer to win souls and positively influence their sphere of influence for Christ. Evangelism is the job of every Spirit-filled believer and the role of the five-fold ministry is in equipping believers for the work of ministry.

2. Operating in Power: Everyone in the community can and should experience the manifest power of God regularly. We expect God to move powerfully in our services and in our lives. We commit to being God-sensitive, rather than seeker-sensitive or seeker-offensive. We are God's Battle axe and weapon of war.

3. Caring Extremely: We care for people and we have to show it. Caring extremely for individuals, also recognizes the importance of making newcomers feel welcomed and cared for as soon as they come into contact with us and continues until they are fully embedded as members of the local assembly.

4. Excellence Always: We demonstrate Kingdom Excellence. We have a mindset of excellence in all aspects of ministry, including media presentation and online engagement. The focus on excellence complements the Spirit-filled, unapologetic nature of the community.

5. Intimacy With God: The secret of our power and strength lies in our intimacy with God, remaining in His presence and being a custodian of His secrets. We believe that our highest calling is to be conformed to the image of His Son, Jesus and to become Sons of the Most High God.

CORE VALUES

•WE ARE RAISING ISSACHARS: We are a tribe who not only understand the times, but also know what to do. We are training people to be prophets and prophets to be people.

•WE CELEBRATE VICTORIES: We celebrate every miracle because it is meant to become a movement, not just a moment.

•WE EXPECT THE MIRACULOUS: Everywhere we go and every time we meet together, we expect God to show up and the enemy to lose ground.

•WE ARE A WORD CHURCH: We believe in and live our lives by the Word of God and because it is settled in heaven, we will not change for situations or popular culture. We therefore anticipate persecution.

•WE USE PRAYER & WORSHIP AS A WEAPON: The army has a sword and a spade. We war as we build; we never lay the sword down. Everyone is expected to be a dedicated "prayer" and actively participate in corporate prayers.

•WE ARE UNOFFENDABLE: We cultivate pure hearts by forgiving easily. "To the pure all things are pure" because love believes the best about people.

•WE ARE ACCOUNTABLE: Our ministry is traceable. We are accountable. We are a part of a larger family. We are not renegades.

•WE ARE APPROACHABLE: We value feedback and criticism that edifies. Though we give audience, we will not automatically adopt every suggestion put forward.

•WE HONOR OUR LEADERS: We honour each other and give more honour to our leaders without placing them on a pedestal and treating them as infallible, hence the need to constantly intercede for them. Honour proceeds miracles. Familiarity stops the miraculous.

CORE VALUES

•WE ARE A TRANS-GENERATIONAL MOVEMENT: We accept the call to reach every generation. We recognise that different generations can have different roles to play.

•WE HAVE A JOSHUA SPIRIT: We believe promotion comes from service, as stated emphatically by Jesus (Matt 20:26-28, Matt 23:11-12, Mark 10:42-45; Luke 22:25-27). As a leader your job is to work yourself out of a job, by setting up durable systems that work with minimal or no intervention. You also identify your replacement and equip them. We willingly yield our place when the Lord anoints another to take over, because then we are positioned for greater things.

•WE ARE ALL IN: We evangelise personally, care extremely, demonstrate the Holy Spirit and the power of God regularly and naturally. Discipleship is the removal of our best excuses. We live our lives on the offensive, "Exhausted yet pursuing the enemy." (Judges 8:4). We put our hands to the plough and never look back.

•WE MAKE ROOM FOR MISTAKES: Trying new things is better than staying at status-quo. We are in a constant state of flexibility, sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit, in search of excellence and the outworking of the will of God.

•WE BELIEVE FOR EVERY BELIEVER: Every believer can do what Jesus did. Every believer can be a witness for Jesus, prophesy, heal the sick, raise the dead, baptize, cast out demons...

•WE PROTECT UNITY: Kingdom principles trump personal preferences. We don't break ranks; we follow Matthew 18 for conflict resolution. We are not ignorant of the devices of the enemy.

•WE ARE GENEROUS; We understand that finances are not about our Kingdom but about the stewardship of His kingdom and resources.

•WE LIVE A DISENTANGLED LIFE: Our outward ministry doesn't replace our church excellence and our church excellence doesn't replace our outward mission. Our public, private and secret lives aim to please the Lord.

ABOUT

Tomi Arayomi is an internationally recognised prophet with more than 20 years experience in prophetic ministry. His desire is to bring forth the authenticity and integrity of the prophetic and its power to change lives all over the world.

Tomi received the Lord Jesus at the age of 15 and began ministry at 16 years old serving as a pastor under Foundation Faith Church. He served there and planted over 10 churches on university campuses UK wide whilst studying law at the University of Hertfordshire. He was later recognised for his apostolic and prophetic anointing and was commissioned under Christian International by Dr Bill Hamon and Dr Sharon Stone in November 2010.

Tomi has since been featured on mainstream media including BBC, Revelation TV, the Times Malawi, TBN, Channels TV where he has been recognized for his national and personal prophetic accuracy. Tomi is a governmental prophet and has had the privilege of consulting prophetically with leaders of nations in their homes at the United Nations and in Parliament.

In 2019, a few months before the UK went into lockdown, Tomi was led by the Lord to relaunch RIG Nation which he had originally founded in 2007. RIG stands for Restoring Issachar's Generation, a mission based on 1 Chronicles 12:32: "The sons of Issachar who had an understanding of the times to know what Israel ought to do." The ministry's vision is to restore the apostolic and prophetic ministry back into the Body of Christ and to equip this generation to be in a position and condition for use by God.

In April 2020, Tomi launched Pioneers Church as an online church which together with other training and social commentary programmes, has attracted an international audience of over 100,000 subscribers on RIG Nation's YouTube channel. During the lockdown, Tomi filmed over 100 training videos which now form the basis of the RIG Nation's School of Apostles and Prophets and in June 2021, launched apostolic centres in London, United Kingdom and Lagos, Nigeria.

At the start of 2022, Tomi heard the Lord calling for crusades to be held across Africa and in other continents also. Recognising a deep sense of urgency the Lord had placed within his spirit, Tomi launched the first crusade in Warri Kingdom, Delta State, Nigeria, in February 2022, followed quickly by a crusade in Benin City and with a schedule each month in other nations and continents.

Tomi is the author of nine books, the most recent being "Eat, Sleep, Prophecy, Repeat" and "The Cosmopolitan Christian".

Tomi and his wife Tahmar have three beautiful sons, Harvey, Perez and Silas. After hearing a word from the Lord, the family recently relocated from Nigeria to the RIG Nation HQ in Houston, Texas, USA.
